

Ground Breaking Ceremony
Generator Project

The City of La Feria invites the public to a ground breaking ceremony for the generator project funded through the Disaster Recovery Program grant of the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) through the Texas Department of Rural Affairs in the amount of \$243,611. The ground breaking will take place at the La Feria Lift Station at the corner of South Canal and Spruce at 11:15 A.M.

This project will provide generator backups at four of the existing lift stations in La Feria, namely Lilac Lift Station, located approximately three hundred feet east of the intersection of FM506 (Main Street) and Lilac Avenue; Parker Road Lift Station, located approximately one hundred feet south of the intersection of Parker Road and Business 83; Canal Street Lift Station, located approximately one hundred feet south of the intersection of W. Spruce and Canal Street; and Arroyo Heights Lift Station, located approximately three thousand feet south of the intersection of Dodd Lane and FM 506 (Main Street). At the completion of this project, all lift stations in La Feria will be equipped with generators for the continuous operation of the lift stations and uninterrupted sewage treatment. Through this grant and other grants, the City strives to promote a better quality of life for all residents.
