

Ground Breaking Ceremony  
Street Project

The City of La Feria invites the public to a ground breaking ceremony for the street paving project that is being funded through the Hurricane Dolly Disaster Recovery Grant awarded to Cameron County from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) through the Texas Department of Rural Affairs (TDRA). The ground breaking ceremony will be held on Monday, July 26, 2010 at 11:00 A.M. at the corner of 9<sup>th</sup> Street and Main (FM 506).

The City will receive \$990,880 in grant funds as a sub-recipient entity to the Cameron County application. Streets in La Feria to be improved are:

9<sup>th</sup> Street, from Main to Canal  
East Street, from Business 83 to Magnolia  
North Parker Road, from Expressway 83 to Windsong Village  
Pancho Maples Drive, from Main to West St.  
Canal Street, from 4<sup>th</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> Street  
Fourth Street, from Canal to West St.  
Parker Rd., from Business 83 to Magnolia  
Canal Street, from Pancho Maples Drive to Spruce
