The **City of La Feria** will receive bids for **Unit 1 AB: AN-49 Levee Crossing Improvements** until Tuesday, May 28, 2013 at 10:00 A.M. at **115 E. Commercial Ave., La Feria, Texas (City Hall)**. The bid package should be marked "Seal Bid – AN-49 Levee Crossing Improvements" and sent to the attention of Sunny K. Philip, City Manager. The bids will be publicly opened and read aloud on Tuesday, May 28, 2013 at 10:00 A.M. at **115 E. Commercial Ave., La Feria, Texas (City Hall)**.

Bids are invited for several items and quantities of work as follows:

Unit 1A – 1 Levee Crossing

Unit 1A – Additive Alternate

A bid bond in the amount of 5 percent (5%) of the bid issued by an acceptable surety

shall be submitted with each bid. A certified check or bank draft payable to the **City of La Feria** or negotiable U.S. Government Bonds (as par value) may be submitted in lieu of the Bid Bond. Attention is called to the fact that not less than, the federally determined prevailing wage rate (Davis-Bacon and Related Acts), as issued by the **Texas General Land Office** and contained in the contract documents, must be paid on this project. In addition, the successful bidder must ensure that employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of race, color, religion, sex, age or national origin. The City of La Feria is an Equal Opportunity Provider and Employer.

A Mandatory pre-bid conference will be held at the City of La Feria City Hall on Tuesday, **May 21, 2013 at 10:00 A.M.**

The City of La Feria Section 3 Policy seeks to ensure that to the greatest extent feasible, training, employment and contracting opportunities created by the City 's receipt of federal housing and community development funds are made available to "Section 3 Residents" and "Section 3 Businesses". The awarded construction contractor will be responsible for meeting the requirements of this policy. The City's Section 3 Policy is included in the bid documents.

The **City of La Feria** reserves the right to reject any or all bids or to waive any informality in the bidding.

Bids may be held by the **City of La Feria** for a period not to exceed 90 days from the date of the bid opening for the purpose of reviewing the bids and investigating the bidders' qualifications prior to the contract award.

All contractors/subcontractors that are debarred, suspended, or otherwise excluded from or ineligible for participation on federal assistance programs, may not undertake any activity in part or in full under this project.
