Commissioner Lozano made a motion to approve Ordinance 2018-01 temporarily closing certain streets during the 2018 Fiesta de La Feria. The motion was seconded by Mayor Pro- Tem Hoff and passed unanimously. Ms. Hayward read the caption of the Ordinance.
