WHEREAS, Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1968, as amended, prohibits discrimination in housing and declares it a national policy to provide, within constitutional limits, for fair housing in the United States; and

WHEREAS, the principal of **Fair Housing** is not only national law and national policy, but a fundamental concept and entitlement for all Americans; and

WHEREAS, the 42nd anniversary of this **National Fair Housing Law**, the month of April, provides an opportunity for all Americans to recognize that complete success in the goal of equal housing opportunity can only be accomplished with the help and cooperation of all Americans.

NOW, THEREFORE, WE, the City Commission of the City of La Feria, do proclaim April as "**Fair Housing Month**" in the City of La Feria and do hereby urge all citizens of this locality to become aware of and support the **Fair Housing Law**.




