

RESOLUTION 2010-13

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LA FERIA, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A CDBG DISASTER RECOVERY NON-ENTITLEMENT GRANT PROGRAM PERFORMANCE STATEMENT AND BUDGET AMENDMENT TO THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF RURAL AFFAIRS FOR CONTRACT NO. DRS010089; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACT AS THE CITY'S EXECUTIVE OFFICER AND AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE IN ALL MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE CITY'S PARTICIPATION IN THE DISASTER RECOVERY GRANT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of La Feria desires to develop a viable urban community, including decent housing and a suitable living environment and expanding economic opportunities, principally for persons of low/moderate income; and

WHEREAS, certain conditions exist including those risen as the result of Hurricane Dolly which represent a threat to the public health and safety; and

WHEREAS, the City of La Feria received a grant award in the amount of \$243,611 for the purchase and installation of four emergency back up generators; and

WHEREAS, the bid submitted by the responsible bidder in the amount of \$252,375.00 is higher than funds available and a performance statement amendment, budget modification and additional funding commitment by the City of La Feria will allow the completion of the project; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and in the best interest of the City of La Feria to apply for an amendment to the performance statement and project budget;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LA FERIA, TEXAS:

1. That a CDBG Disaster Recovery Non-entitlement Grant Program Performance Statement and budget amendment and other associated items are hereby authorized to be filed on behalf of the City with the Texas Department of Rural Affairs.
2. That the City's application be placed in continued funding under the Disaster Recovery Fund.
3. That the application remains for \$243,611 of TDRA grant funds to carry out an eligible Disaster Recovery project.

4. That the city requests transfer of \$26,797 allocated for Planning and Project Delivery to be transferred to Sewer Facilities to carry out the project.
5. That the City of La Feria commits \$32,060 from its Water and Wastewater Fund for the gap needed to fund the project.
4. That the City directs and designates the City Manager as the City's Chief Executive Officer and Authorized Representative to act in all matters in connection with this application and the City's participation in the Texas Community Development Block Grant Program.


