RESOLUTION 2010-16

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF LA FERIA, TEXAS AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION TO THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT **OF AGRICULTURE** (USDA) **FOR** CONSTRUCTION OF A WELLNESS CENTER AND FARMER'S MARKET UNDER THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE USDA COMMUNITY **FACILITIES** PROGRAM, AND **AUTHORIZING** OFFICIALS TO APPLY AND EXECUTE DOCUMENTS RELATED TO SAID APPLICATION ASSISTANCE

WHEREAS, the City of La Feria is a Home-Rule municipality located in Cameron County, Texas created in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 9 of the Texas Local Government Code and operating pursuant to enabling legislation of the State of Texas, the Home-Rule Charter and Code of Ordinances of the City of La Feria; and

WHEREAS, the City of La Feria continues to experience steady growth and as a result an increase in demand of services; and

WHEREAS, the City of La Feria, as well as the Rio Grande Valley as a whole, has a high incidence of diabetes and obesity in children and adults; and

WHEREAS, the City of La Feria deems it necessary to develop a Wellness Center and Farmer's Market to promote good health and nutrition in the community, and

WHEREAS, the City of La Feria, Cameron County, Texas deems it necessary and proper to apply for a Community Facilities loan/grant in the amount of \$3,000,000 to construct a Wellness Center and Farmer's Market under the Rules and Regulations of the United States Department of Agriculture.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF LA FERIA, TEXAS THAT:

- 1. The recitals set forth above are found to be true and correct, and they are hereby adopted by the City Commission and made part of this resolution for all purposes.
- 2. The City of La Feria authorizes the submission of an application for a Community Facilities loan/grant to the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) for the construction of a Wellness Center and Farmer's Market under the Rules and Regulations of the United States Department of Agriculture in the amount of \$3,000,000.
- 3. Mayor Steve Brewer, as the Signatory Agent of the application for this loan/grant may sign the necessary loan/grant documents and have the authority to pledge assets to secure the repayment of the loan under Rules and Regulations of the United States Department

of Agriculture; and to sign the acceptance of the loan/grant assistance, when made, and any other documents required to complete the project, on behalf of the City of La Feria, Cameron County, Texas.
