At 6:00 P.M., La Feria Economic Development Corporation President Ms. Betty Jo Dunlap thanked everyone for coming and asked all present to rise and recite aloud the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America. She then declared a quorum of the La Feria Economic Development Corporation Board of Directors was present and called the meeting to order. Ms. Dunlap announced that this is a 4B Corporation.

CONSIDER AND TAKE ACTION TO CANCEL THE PREVIOUSLY APPROVED ROAD CONSTRUCTION PROJECT ASSOCIATED WITH THE NATURE PARK

City Manager/Executive Director Mr. Sunny K. Philip explained that since the Board authorized the expenditure of funds for the paving of the perimeter road of the Nature Park, certain items have developed that require the immediate need to purchase a tractor to maintain the slopped area at the Nature Park. Mr. Philip recommended that the Board cancel the previously approved expenditure by official action. Mr. John Hernandez

moved to cancel the previously approved road construction project associated with the Nature Park. Ms. Angelica P. Baldivia seconded the motion, and the motion carried by unanimous vote of the LFEDC Board.

CONSIDER AND TAKE ACTION TO SELL PROPERTY LOCATED AT 908 NORTH TICHENOR AVENUE TO SOUTH TEXAS COLLABORATIVE FOR HOUSING DEVELOPMENT AND TO LOAN \$20,000 FOR THE REPAIRS TO MAKE THE HOUSE READY FOR OCCUPANCY

City Manager/Executive Director Mr. Sunny K. Philip explained that the nonprofit Board is seeking to purchase the property located on North Tichenor Avenue from the LFEDC and to borrow \$20,000 for fixing up the house. The loan will be secured with a first lien on the property. Mr. Victor Gonzalez, Jr. moved to sell the property located at 908 North Tichenor Avenue to South Texas Collaborative for Housing Development and to loan \$20,000 for the repairs to make the house ready for occupancy. Ms. Lori Weaver seconded the motion, and the motion carried by unanimous vote of the LFEDC Board.

CONSIDER AND TAKE ACTION TO APPROVE THE PURCHASE OF A TRACTOR AND SHREDDER AND A SMALL MOWER FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF THE NATURE PARK

City Manager/Executive Director Mr. Sunny K. Philip explained that the bigger tractor will cost \$50,017.40 with attachments and the smaller mower will cost approximately \$15,000.00. A copy of the proposal for the first tractor was included in the board member packets for their review. Mr. Victor Gonzalez, Jr. moved to approve the purchase of a tractor and shredder and a small mower for the maintenance of the Nature Park. Ms. Angelica P. Baldivia seconded the motion, and the motion carried by unanimous vote of the LFEDC Board.

CONSIDER AND TAKE ACTION TO APPROVE/DENY FUNDING REQUEST **FROM** THE SOUTH **TEXAS** COLLABORATIVE FOR HOUSING DEVELOPMENT FOR \$90,000 ADDITIONAL LOAN FUNDS FOR THE INITIAL COST DEVELOPING THE OF MULTIFAMILY HOUSING **DEVELOPMENT PROJECT**

City Manager/Executive Director Mr. Sunny K. Philip explained that the proposed multifamily housing project is moving along well and the nonprofit is seeking the LFEDC's assistance for funding. The LFEDC previously approved a loan in the amount of \$10,000 for initial funding. There is a need for an additional \$90,000 for the multifamily project to move to the next level. Ms. Mary Garcia moved to approve the funding request from the South Texas Collaborative for Housing Development Fund, Inc. for \$90,000 additional loan funds for the initial cost of developing the multifamily housing development project. Ms. Lori Weaver seconded the motion, and the motion carried by unanimous vote of the LFEDC Board.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

Board President Ms. Betty Jo Dunlap declared the public comment session open. No one signed up to comment before the Board, so Ms. Dunlap declared the public comment session closed.

There being no further business to conduct, Ms. Lori Weaver moved to adjourn the meeting. Ms. Mary Garcia seconded the motion, and the motion carried by unanimous vote of the LFEDC Board.
