

ORDINANCE 2010-04

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LA FERIA TEMPORARILY CLOSING CERTAIN AND SPECIFIED STREETS WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF LA FERIA AND MODIFYING TRAFFIC PATTERNS ON CERTAIN STREETS FOR THE PURPOSE OF ENSURING THE SAFETY AND GENERAL WELFARE OF THE PUBLIC DURING THE CITY OF LA FERIA'S FOURTH OF JULY PARADE AND CELEBRATION WHICH WILL BE HELD ON SATURDAY, JULY 3, 2010 AT THE VETERANS MEMORIAL PARK/SPORTS COMPLEX FROM 5:00 TO 10:00 P.M.

WHEREAS, the citizens of the City of La Feria have shown much interest in participating in a Fourth of July community celebration and parade; and

WHEREAS, such celebration will promote the goodwill of the community and entice residents of the community to participate in a family picnic outing; and

WHEREAS, the safety and general welfare of the participants and the general public are of prime concern; and

WHEREAS, the temporary closing of certain and specified streets to vehicular traffic will improve safety and provide an increased level of protection for participants; and;

WHEREAS, the impact of street closure will be minimal to residents and the general public residing in the area,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LA FERIA, TEXAS that the following streets be closed to all vehicular traffic on **Saturday, July 3, 2010 from 4:00 PM until 6:00 PM**

1. Main Street from North Central to Pancho Maples Drive
2. Pancho Maples Drive from Main Street to the west side of Veterans Memorial Park/Sports Complex.


