RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING APPLICATION

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF LA FERIA, TEXAS HEREINAFTER REFERRED TO AS "APPLICANT," DESIGNATING CERTAIN OFFICIALS AS BEING RESPONSIBLE FOR, ACTING FOR, AND ON BEHALF OF THE APPLICANT IN DEALING WITH THE TEXAS PARKS & WILDLIFE DEPARTMENT, HEREINAFTER REFERRED TO AS "DEPARTMENT," FOR THE PURPOSE OF PARTICIPATING IN THE LOCAL PARK GRANT HEREINAFTER REFERRED TO AS THE "PROGRAM": PROGRAM, CERTIFYING THAT THE APPLICANT IS ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE **PROGRAM ASSISTANCE: CERTIFYING** THAT THE APPLICANT MATCHING SHARE IS READILY AVAILABLE; CERTIFYING THAT THE PARK SITE WAS DEDICATED FOR PERMANENT PUBLIC PARK AND RECREATIONAL USES FROM A PAST GRANT PROGRAM WITH THE TEXAS PARKS AND WILDLIFE DEPARTMENT; AND CERTIFYING THAT THE APPLICATION HAS BEEN SUBMITTED TO THE APPROPRIATE REGIONAL COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS FOR THE TEXAS REVIEW AND **COMMENT SYSTEM (TRACS) REVIEW.**

WHEREAS, The Applicant is fully eligible to receive assistance under the Program; and

WHEREAS, the Applicant is desirous of authorizing an official to represent and act for the Applicant in dealing with the Department concerning the Program;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE APPLICANT:

- SECTION 1: That the Applicant hereby certifies that they are eligible to receive assistance under the Program, and that notice of the application has been posted according to local public hearing requirements.
- **SECTION 2:** That the Applicant hereby certifies that the matching share for this application is readily available at this time.
- SECTION 3: That the Applicant hereby authorizes and directs its <u>City Manager</u> to act for the Applicant in dealing with the Department for the purposes of the Program, and that <u>Sunny K. Philip</u> is hereby officially designated as the representative in this regard.
- The Applicant hereby specifically authorizes the official to make application to the Department concerning the site, known as <u>Veterans Memorial Sports Complex</u> in the <u>City of La Feria</u> of <u>Cameron County</u> for use as a park site and is hereby dedicated for public park and recreation purposes in perpetuity. Projects with federal monies may have differing requirements.

SECTION 5: That the Applicant hereby certifies that a copy of the application has been submitted to the appropriate regional council of governments for Texas Review and Comments System consideration.
