

## RESOLUTION 2010-24

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LA FERIA, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A ROUND TWO DISASTER RECOVERY SUPPLEMENTAL ALLOCATION APPLICATION TO THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF RURAL AFFAIRS FOR THE DISASTER RECOVERY SUPPLEMENTAL FUND; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACT AS THE CITY'S EXECUTIVE OFFICER AND AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE IN ALL MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE CITY'S PARTICIPATION IN THE ROUND TWO DISASTER RECOVERY SUPPLEMENTAL ALLOCATION.**

**WHEREAS**, the City Commission of the City of La Feria desires to eliminate flooding in residential neighborhoods, provide decent housing, create a suitable living environment, and expand economic opportunities, principally for persons of low-to-moderate income; and

**WHEREAS**, certain conditions exist which represent a threat to the public health and safety; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of La Feria is desirous of providing fair housing to all persons through the provisions of the above; and

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary and in the best interest of the City of La Feria to apply for funding under the Disaster Recovery Supplemental Fund;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF LA FERIA, TEXAS:**

1. The City of La Feria, through the City Manager, pursue Round Two Disaster Recovery Supplemental funding made available through the Texas Department of Rural Affairs to be used to assist in reaching the city's goals of eliminating threats to public health and safety during storm events.
2. The City Manager is designated as the authorized person to execute all documents pertaining to the application and funding.
3. The City of La Feria continue its commitment toward impacting the need of fair housing for low to moderate income families in La Feria.
4. The City of La Feria authorizes the submittal of an application to the Disaster Recovery Supplemental Fund in the amount of \$18,474,242 of grant funds.


