

RESOLUTION 2011-04

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LA FERIA, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF HAZARD MITIGATION GRANT PROGRAM APPLICATION TO THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT FOR THE HURRICANE ALEX DECLARATION; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACT AS THE CITY'S EXECUTIVE OFFICER AND AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE IN ALL MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE CITY'S PARTICIPATION IN THE HAZARD MITIGATION GRANT PROGRAM FOR THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF A GENERATOR AT THE FIRE STATION TO PROVIDE BACKUP POWER FOR THE FIRST RESPONDER FACILITY.

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of La Feria desires to develop a viable urban community, including decent housing and a suitable living environment and expanding economic opportunities, principally for persons of low/moderate income; and

WHEREAS, certain conditions exist which represent a threat to the public health and safety; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and in the best interest of the City of La Feria to apply for funding under the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program for the purchase and installation of a generator to provide backup power to the City of La Feria Fire Station,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LA FERIA, TEXAS:

- 1 That Hazard Mitigation Grant Program application is hereby authorized to be filed on behalf of the City with the Texas Department of Emergency Management.
2. That the City's application be placed in consideration for funding under the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program.
- 3 That the City of La Feria will provide a 25% match to the amount of the application with related engineering and administration.
4. That the City directs and designates the City Manager as the City's Chief Executive Officer and Authorized Representative to act in all matters in connection with this application and the City's participation in the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program.
