A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LA FERIA, TEXAS IN SUPPORT OF THE US 77 UPGRADE PROJECT TO INTERSTATE STANDARDS

WHEREAS, the City of La Feria supports the Texas Department of Transportation's (TxDOT) Upgrade US 77 Highway Plan and supports the US 77 Upgrade Project to Interstate Standards from US 83 in Harlingen to Interstate 37 (I-37) in Corpus Christi.

WHEREAS, the US 77 Upgrade Project improvements are important to the City of La Feria's future development as this project will accomplish the following:

- Improve safety by elimination of at-grade crossings, where accidents have occurred.
- Provide a free-flowing trade route which will improve energy efficiency by providing relief routes around Driscoll and Riviera.
