## **RESOLUTION 2012-35**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LA FERIA, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF AN AMY YOUNG BARRIER REMOVAL PROGRAM APPLICATION TO THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND COMMUNITY AFFAIRS FOR THE HOUSING TRUST FUND; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACT AS THE CITY'S AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE IN ALL MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE CITY'S PARTICIPATION IN THE AMY YOUNG BARRIER REMOVAL PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of La Feria desires to develop a viable urban community including decent housing and a suitable living environment and expanding economic opportunities, principally for persons of low-to-moderate income; and

WHEREAS, certain conditions exist which represent a threat to the public health and safety; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and in the best interests of the City of La Feria to apply for funding under the Amy Young Barrier Removal program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LA FERIA, TEXAS, THAT:

- 1. An Amy Young Barrier Removal Program application for the Housing Trust Fund is hereby authorized to be filed on behalf of the City with the Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs.
- 2. The City's application to the Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs' Reservation System be for home modifications necessary for accessibility and the elimination of hazardous conditions.
- 3. The City Commission directs and designates the City Manager, Sunny K. Philip, as the City's Authorized Representative to act in all matters in connection with this application and the City's participation in the program, including authorization to execute agreements with the Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs on behalf of the City.
