## **ORDINANCE 2013-05**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LA FERIA, TEXAS AUTHORIZING THE CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AT THE VETERANS MEMORIAL PARK/SPORTS COMPLEX DURING THE DAYS OF CELEBRATION ON JUNE 28 AND JUNE 29, 2013 OR ON AN ALTERNATE DATE SELECTED BY THE EVENT PLANNING COMMITTEE AND APPROVED BY THE CITY MANAGER FOR THE CITY OF LA FERIA INDEPENDENCE DAY CELEBRATION AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of La Feria (City), Texas is a public agency and Home Rule Municipal Corporation formed pursuant to TEX. LOC. GOV'T CODE § 9.001, et seq.; and

WHEREAS, the Veterans Memorial Park/Sports Complex is a City owned park; and

WHEREAS, the City of La Feria has authorized festivities in conjunction with the Independence Day Celebration to be held on June 28 and June 29, 2013; and

WHEREAS, the Event Planning Committee has recommended that consumption of alcoholic beverages during the hours of celebration be allowed at the park; and

WHEREAS, alcoholic beverage sales or use is not permitted at city owned parks under normal circumstances unless specifically permitted by the City Commission,

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LA FERIA, TEXAS, THAT:

- 1. The recitals set forth above are found to be true and correct, and they are hereby adopted by the City Commission and made a part of this ordinance for all purposes.
- 2. Alcoholic beverage consumption at the Veterans Memorial Park/Sports Complex is hereby authorized in conjunction with the Independence Day Celebration planned for June 28 and June 29, 2013 or on an alternate date selected in 2013 by the Event Planning Committee and approved by the City Manager provided however, no glass containers are allowed.
- 3. This ordinance shall be effective upon passage.
