FINANCIAL REPORTS FOR THE MONTH OF SEPTEMBER 2014

Finance Director Ms. Maria Chavero reviewed the financial reports for the month of September 2014 with the board, reviewing both the monthly and year-to-date figures for the month. Ms. Chavero said that there would be some adjustments made for the end of the fiscal year. She then reviewed the Performance Indicators for the month. After review and all questions answered, Board Chairman Mr. Adolfo Lopez announced that the reports would be filed for audit.

REVIEW BID TABULATION FOR THE CATHODIC PROTECTION EQUIPMENT FOR CLARIFIERS AND ELEVATED WATER TANK AND CONSIDER AND TAKE ACTION TO RECOMMEND TO THE CITY COMMISSION AWARD OF CONTRACT TO THE LOWEST MOST QUALIFIED AND RESPONSIBLE BIDDER.

City Manager Mr. Sunny K. Philip explained that the Cathodic Protection Equipment would prolong the life of the existing clarifiers and the water tank. He said that there are not too many companies doing this type of work, so the City received only one bid and that was from Corrpro Waterworks of 2069A Lake Industrial Court, Conyers, Georgia in the amount of \$71,655.00. The City Engineer reviewed the bid and they are recommending award of contract to the sole bidder Corrpro Waterworks. The funding for this project is through a grant with the Department of Agriculture and the City only has until November 11, 2014 to commit the funds. After review and all questions answered, Mr. Ralph Muse moved to recommend to the City Commission to award contract to Corrpro Waterworks for the Cathodic Protection Equipment in the amount of \$71,655.00. Mr. Ovidio Saldivar seconded the motion, and the motion carried by unanimous vote of the board.

REPORTS BY STAFF AND DISCUSSION WITH THE BOARD

• Water and Wastewater Systems Improvement Project

City Manager Mr. Sunny K. Philip reported the following:

- Water and Wastewater Systems Improvement Project Cornett Construction is finishing up the looping of the project on the east side. There is one hookup on Parker Road left to be completed. They have done a good job. They will be starting on replacing the AC waterline which will be funded through 100% grant from Texas Water Development Board.
- The other component to the TDA grant is the Ultra Violet System. There is a deadline of November 11, 2015 for completion of this project. The bid opening for this project will be October 23, 2014.
