REPORTS BY STAFF AND DISCUSSION WITH THE BOARD

• Water and Wastewater Systems Improvement Project

City Manager Mr. Sunny K. Philip reported the following.

• Typically staff brings all bids pertaining to the Water and Wastewater System to the Utilities Board for recommendation to the City Commission; however, there were bids received for the Water Plant Project I-3 Building Structure for the Ultra Violet Disinfection System Building that were presented directly to the City Commission for approval. The predicament that the City was under was that the contract had to be executed within a certain date. R. P. Constructors who built the Wastewater Treatment Plant and the expansions on the Water Treatment Plant was the low bidder in the amount of \$459,000.00. Funding will include \$200,000.00 from the Texas Department of Agriculture.

- A second project is the replacement of the AC line and a challenging issue was encountered in the Innovative Block section on First Street, but that issue has been taken care of and the project is moving along.
- On the west side, the Alto Real Project contract was advertised and awarded through the (Cameron) County. The preconstruction meeting was held last Thursday here at City Hall. This is a subdivision that has 25 homes and the completion date on this contract is November 2015.
- There are several items being reviewed by the Texas Water Development Board (TWDB) at this time.
- There is another grant opportunity from the Community Development Block Grant Program in the amount of approximately \$260,000.00. The City has been putting priority on the water and wastewater system projects. These projects benefit the entire community.
- The Texas Water Development Board has a 2 billion dollar fund available, and the City is keeping an eye on that for any opportunities.

 Under the Restore Act funding, the City has submitted two proposals. One is to expand the Nature Center and the other is to develop a 400 acre site in the Tio Cano area.
