ORDINANCE 2014-04

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LA FERIA TEMPORARILY CLOSING CERTAIN AND SPECIFIED STREETS WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF LA FERIA AND MODIFYING TRAFFIC PATTERNS ON CERTAIN STREETS FOR THE PURPOSE OF ENSURING THE SAFETY AND GENERAL WELFARE OF THE PUBLIC DURING THE ST. FRANCIS XAVIER CATHOLIC CHURCH FESTIVAL TO BE HELD ON SUNDAY, MAY 18, 2014

WHEREAS, the citizens of the city of La Feria have shown much interest in participating in the St. Francis Xavier Catholic Church Festivals; and

WHEREAS, such festivals will promote the goodwill of the community and entice economic development in the community; and

WHEREAS, the safety and general welfare of the participants and the general public are of prime concern; and

WHEREAS, the temporary closing of certain and specified streets to vehicular traffic will improve safety and provide an increased level of protection for participants; and;

WHEREAS, the impact of the street closure will be a minimal impact to residents and to the general public residing in the area.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LA FERIA, TEXAS that the following streets be closed to all vehicular traffic on Sunday, May 18, 2014 from 6:00 AM until 10:00 PM.

- 1. West Street from W. Magnolia Avenue south to the beginning of West St. Blvd.
- 2. Cypress Avenue from southbound West St. Blvd. to 300 feet west on Cypress.
- 3. The Ordinance shall be effective upon approval.
