

RESOLUTION 2014-16

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF LA FERIA, TEXAS APPROVING THE CITY OF LA FERIA REVISED PARK PLAN AND CONFIRMING THE SUBMISSION OF THE PLAN REVISIONS TO THE TEXAS PARKS AND WILDLIFE DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, the City of La Feria is a Home-Rule municipality located in Cameron County, Texas created in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 9 of the Texas Local Government Code and operating pursuant to enabling legislation of the State of Texas, the Home-Rule Charter and Code of Ordinances of the City of La Feria; and

WHEREAS, the City of La Feria is interested in improving the quality of life of the residents by offering a variety of park and recreational options; and

WHEREAS, the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department offers competitive funding for park and recreational improvements, and the City of La Feria filed a revised Park Master Plan with the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of La Feria conducted a public hearing in preparation for adopting a revised Master Park Plan; and


WHEREAS, the City Commission has determined that it is in the best interest of the City of La Feria to adopt a revised Park Master Plan and file with the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF LA FERIA, TEXAS THAT:

1. The Master Park Plan revisions sent to the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department on June 27, 2014 are found to be true and correct, and they are hereby adopted by the City Commission and made part of this resolution for all purposes.
2. It is the finding of the City Commission of the City of La Feria that adopting a new Park Master Plan is in the best interest of the City.
3. The revised Park Master Plan is hereby approved, a copy of which is included as a part of this resolution hereof.
4. The City Manager or his designee is directed to file a copy of the Park Master Plan with the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department.
