

## **RESOLUTION 2015-19**

### **A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF LA FERIA, TEXAS APPOINTING A REPRESENTATIVE TO THE REGIONAL STORM WATER TASK FORCE**

**WHEREAS**, THE City Commission of the City of La Feria has determined to enter into an Interlocal Agreement with Texas A&M University – Kingsville, as a manner by which the City can actively participate in a Regional Task Force formed to respond and aid compliance with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality Phase II Storm Water Rules; and

**WHEREAS**, the City desires to accomplish the goals of responding and complying with the Rules through the formation of a Regional Task Force, established and managed by Texas A&M University – Kingsville; and

**WHEREAS**, the City will appoint one representative to the task force, to act as the liaison between the City and the Task Force, appraising each entity of the other's objectives; and

**WHEREAS**, Texas A&M University – Kingsville will formulate and propose to the Task Force methods and approaches for compliance with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality Phase II Storm Water Rules, including speculative cost analysis and budget projections; and

**WHEREAS**, Texas A&M University – Kingsville will provide research, educational services, and technical support to the Task Force for any adopted methods and approaches for compliance.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LA FERIA, TEXAS THAT:**

PART 1. That the City of La Feria Planning Director is hereby appointed as representative to the Regional Storm Water Task Force and is hereby authorized and directed to act as Liaison between the City of La Feria and the Task Force.

PART 2. That this resolution shall take effect immediately after its passage.
