**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF LA FERIA AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION TO THE HOMELAND SECURITY GRANTS DIVISION OF THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE FOR PROJECTS THAT SUPPORT OPERATION BORDER STAR FOR THE 2016 GRANT CYCLE OF THE LOCAL BORDER SECURITY PROGRAM**

**WHEREAS**, the City Commission of the City of La Feria finds it in the best interest of the citizens of La Feria, Texas that the Operation Border Star Project be operated for 2016; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Commission agrees to provide applicable matching funds for the said project as required by the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division grant application; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Commission agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Criminal Justice Division funds, the City Commission assures that the funds will be returned to the Criminal Justice Division in full; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Commission designates Sunny K. Philip, City Manager as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Commission of the City of La Feria authorizes submission of the grant application for the Operation Border Star Project 2016 to the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division.
