

Job Title: <u>Water Distribution and Wastewater Collection System Maintenance</u>

Reports to: Public Works Director

Hourly Employee/ Non-Supervisory/ At-will Employment

Summary and Objective:

The Water Distribution and Wastewater Collections System Maintenance worker is required to perform a variety of duties in order to operate, maintain and repair the facilities of the water distribution and wastewater collection system.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

The intent of this job description is to provide a representative summary of the major duties and responsibilities performed by a Water Distribution & Wastewater Collection System Maintenance worker. Public Works employees may be requested to perform job-related tasks other than those specifically presented in this description. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions of this job.

Physical Abilities:

A City of La Feria WD&WC Maintenance worker must possess the following physical capacities to perform essential job related tasks:

- Corrected vision in order to make visual observations of pump stations, grounds and equipment.
- Repetitive bending, twisting, standing, sitting, reaching, walking, stopping, kneeling, crouching, and crawling.
- Walking at work sites on unpaved streets, uneven ground and cluttered work areas.
- Physical labor with lifting of heavy equipment or objects is routine.
- Ability to convey detailed instructions accurately, loudly, and quickly to other workers when working near loud machinery.
- Ascending and descending ladders, stairs, ramps requiring the use of feet, legs, hands and arms.

Essential Duties:

1. Reads water consumption meters and records volume used by residential and commercial consumers: Walks or drives truck over established route and takes readings of meter dials.



- 2. Inspects meters and connections for defects, damage, and unauthorized connection.
- 3. Indicates irregularities on forms for necessary action by servicing department.
- 4. Verifies readings to locate abnormal consumption and records reasons for fluctuations.
- 5. Turns service off for nonpayment of charges in vacant premises, or on for new occupants.
- 6. Installs water meters in consumer establishment, using hand tools: turns mainline valve to close water flow through line.
- 7. Disconnect water pipe and connects water meter to outlet and inlet pipe unions, using wrench.
- 8. Examines pipes to detect leaks and informs consumer to close faucets.
- 9. Opens mainline valve to admit water flow into building.
- 10. Installs water and wastewater lines.
- 11. Repairs leaks in utility lines using appropriate equipment.
- 12. On call and required to respond to emergencies when needed.
- 13. Work in all types of weather conditions including hot and cold and sever weather
- 14. Work with hazardous chemicals and electricity and around noxious fumes, odors, and dust.
- 15. Work in confined spaces above and below ground with loud machinery and moving equipment.
- 16. Operates equipment and utilizes a variety of hand and power tools to operate, maintain and repair the water supply and distribution and sewer collection and conveyance system.
- 17. Performs repairs and preventative maintenance on pumps, blowers and treatment equipment; prepares treatment chemical solutions; coordinates, completes and inspects repairs, construction and maintenance performed by staff and contractors.
- 18. Available for scheduled and emergency overtime.



- 19. Maintain safety and quality in all aspects of job performance.
- 20. Maintain neat and professional appearance and customer focused approach at all times.
- 21. Shall adhere to City of La Feria's Personnel Policy Manual.
- 22. Perform other related duties as required.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS:

High School Diploma of GED equivalent; Commercial Drivers License; ability to be on 24 hour on-call when needed; previous experience in related work environment preferred; fluently speaks and writes English; bi-lingual in English and Spanish is preferred; ability to operate heavy equipment such as back hoe and heavy trucks, generators, pumps, gauges, common and uncommon hand and power tools, detection devices, phone, lawn mower, grass trimmer, etc.; basic computer knowledge and word processing skills.
