CONSIDER AND TAKE ACTION TO APPROVE OR DENY AN INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF LA FERIA AND CAMERON COUNTY PERTAINING TO OPERATION STONEGARDEN FY2015.

Ms. Sánchez reported on the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement. The City has been allocated \$21,878.00 for this funding cycle. The Grant time frame is one year from October 2016.
