5. CONSENT AGENDA:

A. <u>APPROVAL OF MINUTES FOR CITY COMMISSION MEETING HELD APRIL 11, 2017.</u>

Mayor Pro-Tem Lozano made amotion to approve the minutes for the City Commission meeting held April 11, 2017. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Hoff and passed unanimously.

6. <u>CONSIDERATION AND APPROPRIATE ACTION, IF ANY, TO APPROVE AGREEMENT WITH CAMERON COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 1 FOR FIRE SERVICES.</u>

Commissioner Hoff made a motion to approve the agreement with Cameron County Emergency Services District No. 1 for fire services. The motion was seconded by Mayor Pro-Tem Lozano and passed unanimously.

Commissioner Guevara made a motion to approve Resolution 2017-14 accepting the donation of 0.63 acres out of block 13 E.E. Evens Subdivision from Harold L. Wilson, Jr. and Cynthia Bryscki. Commissioner Hoff seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Mr. Sandoval explained that in January the Commission approved for Severn Trent to do an evaluation of the City's water and wastewater facilities and lift stations at no cost and report their findings to the Commission. The staff at the water and wastewater treatment plants are still employed by the City of La Feria. The Plants, Lift stations, and all equipment are still the property of the City of La Feria. The evaluation prepared by Severn Trent will be presented at the next City Commission Meeting. There was no action taken on this item.
