# MONTHLY FINANCIAL REPORTS FOR THE MONTH OF DECEMBER 2015, JANUARY AND FEBRUARY 2016

Finance Director Ms. Kin Mendoza reviewed the monthly financial reports for the months of December 2015, January and February 2016 discussing monthly revenue and expenditures, sales tax collection, and Comptroller deposits. Mr. Philip explained that the sales tax deposits vary since we receive payment a couple of months after deposits, and in part because some businesses report on a monthly basis and others quarterly. Comptroller deposits for December 2015, January and February 2016 show an increase over the same period one year ago. Following review and discussion, Mr. Shields announced the financial reports to be filed for audit.

### **REPORTS**

### REVOLVING LOAN FUND

Mr. Philip discussed the revolving loan program administered by The Reyna Network and introduced Ms. Thelma Gonzalez of the firm to present a report. The LFIDC has a remaining balance of \$420,000 including \$20,000 from the local match and \$400,000 from the IRP loan. One loan is current and one application is under currently under review. There is also a prospective applicant working with The Reyna Network at this time. A response from USDA is pending regarding utilization of the remaining program funds. The report presented only documents efforts for the revolving loan program. The latest contract with The Reyna Network includes several other elements. We will work the consultant to include the status of other activities in future reports.

There being no further business to conduct, Mr. Garcia Galvez moved to adjourn the meeting. Ms. Guillen seconded the motion, and the motion carried by unanimous vote of the LFIDC board members present.
