FINANCIAL REPORTS FOR THE MONTH OF JUNE 2015

Finance Director Ms. Maria Chavero reviewed the financial reports for the month of June 2015 with the board, reviewing the monthly budget vs. actual for the month and the year-to-date figures. Ms. Chavero announced that the water utility bill can now be paid online, as well as some court fines. She said there is a convenience fee of \$3.00 and an Incode fee of \$1.25. City Manager Mr. Sunny K. Philip added that the fee is paid by the customer and that it is not costing the system any money. Ms. Chavero then reviewed the Performance Indicators for the month. After review and all questions answered, Board Chairman Mr. Adolfo Lopez announced that the reports would be filed for audit.

City Manager Mr. Sunny K. Philip reported the following.

- The 12 Inch AC Water Line Replacement project is complete and staff is now going through the close out process. The contractor has done a very good job.
- Water Line to West Colonias The contractor will start the week of the 27th of July 2015.
- Alto Real Sewer System Improvement Project There are one or two more hookups to be done. These are funded through the CDBG project through Cameron County.
- Wastewater Lines & Sewer Main There is a lift station on Beddoes Road and the Saenz Brothers will be building a brand new lift station on South Kansas City Road. One new project being advertised now is for two new lift stations, one on Bixby Road and the other on Kubiski Road.
- UV System Building is complete and the system has been installed; only waiting on the electrical.
- Cathodic Protection for Clarifiers & Elevated Tank This project has been completed, and it is in the closeout phase.
