At 5:17 P.M., Board Chairman Adolfo Lopez asked all present to rise and recite aloud the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America. After this was done, Chairman Lopez declared that a quorum was present and called the meeting to order.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

Board Chairman Adolfo Lopez declared the public comment session open. No one signed up to speak before the board, so Mr. Lopez declared the public session closed.

CONSIDER AND TAKE ACTION TO RECOMMEND TO THE CITY COMMISSION APPROVAL OF PURCHASE OF SEWER CLEANING MACHINE THROUGH BUYBOARD AND ALSO RECOMMEND APPROVAL OF RESOLUTION FINANCING THE PURCHASE THROUGH GOVERNMENT CAPITAL CORPORATION.

City Manager Sunny K. Philip explained that the sewer cleaning machine purchased approximately 10 years ago has been out of service for several months. It is very hard to get parts to repair the machine and the City has to make a decision to acquire a new truck. The brand name of the existing body is VACON. City employees reviewed

demonstrations of VACON and VACTOR brand and they have demonstration trucks for sale.

VACTOR offered a better price and most of the bigger cities in the area utilize the same brand. The recommendation is to purchase a VACTOR body machine for \$304,675 financed over a 10 year period at a cost of \$37,551 per year with an interest rate of 3.93%. The household cost per month is estimated at \$1.39.

Board member Ralph Muse moved to recommend the City Commission approve the purchase, seconded by Board Member Ovidio Saldivar. The Board approved the action by unanimous vote of the Board Members present.

There being no further business to conduct, Mr. Ralph Muse moved for adjournment of the meeting. Ms. Betty Jo Dunlap seconded the motion, and the motion carried by unanimous vote of the board.
