6. CONSENT AGENDA:

A. APPROVAL OF MINUTES FOR CITY COMMISSION MEETING HELD JANUARY 23, 2018

Commissioner Guevara made a motion to approve all items under consent agenda as presented. The motion was seconded by Mayor Pro-Tem Hoff and passed unanimously.

7. CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION ON INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF LA FERIA AND THE UNIVERSITY OF TEXAS RIO GRANDE VALLEY FOR REPRESENTATIVE APPOINTMENT TO THE REGIONAL TASK FORCE.

Mayor Pro-Tem Hoff made a motion to appoint City Manager Jaime Sandoval as the City's representative to the Regional Task Force.

8. CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION TO APPROVE A PIPELINE CROSSING AGREEMENT AND LICENSE FEE BETWEEN UNION PACIFIC RAILROAD COMPANY AND THE CITY OF LA FERIA.

Commissioner Lozano made a motion to approve a pipeline crossing agreement and license fee between Union Pacific Railroad Company and the City of La Feria. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Guevara and passed unanimously.

9. CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION TO APPROVE A SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT AND RELATED FEES BETWEEN UNION PACIFIC RAILROAD COMPANY AND THE CITY OF LA FERIA.

Commissioner Lozano made a motion to approve a supplemental agreement and related fees between Union Pacific Railroad Company and the City of La Feria. The motion was seconded by Mayor Pro-Tem Hoff and passed unanimously.

10. <u>CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION ON ORDINANCE 2018-02</u> REGARDING FLOOD DAMAGE PREVENTION.

This Ordinance is required for the City to be eligible for grant funding in the future. Commissioner Lozano made a motion to approve Ordinance 2018-02 regarding Flood Damage Prevention. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Guevara and passed unanimously. Upon passage of the Ordinance, City Attorney Hayward read the caption.

11. <u>CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION TO APPROVE AN AGREEMENT</u> WITH TIF SERVICES OF SOUTH TEXAS.

Commissioner Lozano made a motion to table this item. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Zuniga and passed unanimously.

12. <u>CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION TO APPROVE A CONTRACT BETWEEN LA FERIA DANCE FITNESS STUDIO AND CITY OF LA FERIA.</u>

After some discussion it was determined that the Commission required more information on the availability of space at the City's Recreation center. Commissioner Lozano made a motion to table this item. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Garcia and passed unanimously.

13. CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION TO ALLOW THE EXTREME FEMALE FOOTBALL LEAGUE TO USE THE SPORTS COMPLEX FOR HOME GAMES.

The Commission asked that the team look more closely at the facility they are requesting and determine if it properly suits their needs. Commissioner Lozano made a motion to table this item. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Guevara and passed unanimously.
