At 6:00 PM, LFEDC Board President Francisco Loya, Jr. and LFIDC Board Vice President Francisco Garcia led all present in reciting the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America. They then declared that quorums of the LFEDC and LFIDC were present and called the meeting to order.

CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION TO APPROVE THE LA FERIA ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2017-2018.

Mr. Rios noted that the budget is balanced and includes projected revenues and expenditures of \$342,691. There was some discussion regarding properties owned by the Corporation including

four residential properties currently being leased and managed by South Texas Collaborative for Housing Development and a 35 acre plot of undeveloped farm land with a vacant home being maintained by the City.

The LFEDC has a promissory note for the 35 acre lot that was originally in the amount of \$410,000. The note is collateralized using property owned by the La Feria Industrial Development Corporation. The original intent of the land purchase is not clear. Mr. Hoff made a motion to approve the La Feria Economic Development Corporation budget for fiscal year 2017-2018. The motion was seconded by Mr. Guevara and passed unanimously.

CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION TO APPROVE THE LA FERIA INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2017-2018.

Mr. Rios noted that the budget for the La Feria Industrial Development Corporation includes a deficit in the amount of \$86,810. The deficit is due to a balloon payment due on a promissory note held by First Community Bank. Mr. Rios is working with the bank to refinance the note in order to avoid the \$182,193 payment due in January. A budget amendment will be presented to the board once the terms of the agreement have been approved. Discussion turned to the more than 50 properties owned by the LFIDC. It was noted that a bulk of the properties held by the Corporation are either vacant land or residential homes. Francisco Garcia made a motion to approve the La Feria Industrial Development Corporation budget for fiscal year 2017-2018 as presented. The motion was seconded by Mr. de Leon and passed with Ms. Mascorro, Ms. Gomez Vela, Mr. Garcia and Mr. de Leon voting in favor. Mr. Gonzalez abstained.

ADJOURNMENT.

There being no further business to discuss, Mr. Hoff made a motion to adjourn the meeting. the motion was seconded by Ms. Maldonado and passed unanimously.
