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MERCHANDISE VENDOR REGISTRATION GENERAL RULES AND PROCEDURES

VENDOR DEFINITION

Vendor Selling any Item(s), including arts and crafts, for profit at the Fiesta de La Feria Event.

VENDORS

Electricity is included (if needed), you must provide your own extension cord(s). NO POWER STRIPS ALLOWED / You must fill out the electrical needs on the registration form in order to use an electrical outlet at the festival.

Also, bring a pop up tent or concession trailer, tables, chairs and other set-up displays for your booth that does not exceed the space provided, which is 20'x10' per booth.

Vendors Must Display their Company Name at their Booth.

OBJECTIONABLE MATERIAL

Anyone selling or distributing objectionable materials to the public and not in conformity to the theme of the Fiesta de La Feria will not be allowed to participate and will be asked to leave. The Fiesta de La Feria Planning Committee reserves the right to determine what is considered objectionable items. Objectionable items include, but are not limited to the following:

- Knives or items resembling knives
- Guns or items resembling guns
- Bullets or items resembling bullets
- Lighters or flammable materials
- Material depicting marijuana, other illegal drugs, or drug related paraphernalia
- Stink or smoke bombs
- Silly String
- Items resembling cigarettes
- Any item or material not conforming to the theme of the Fiesta de La Feria

Although these items may be considered legal for sale, the Fiesta de la Feria Planning Committee is concerned with their sale to minors. Vendors are asked to use good judgment and consider parental/guardian approval before selling what may be considered "objectionable" items to minors.

ALL BOOTHS MUST BE SET-UP BY 10:00 A.M. ON SATURDAY
