LA FERIA, CAMERON COUNTY, TEXAS LOCATED AT 11572-11552 BUSINESS HWY 83 FROM R-1 SINGLE FAMILY RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT TO MF- MULTI-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT. OWNER; C&MLG, LLC

Commissioner Guevara made a motion to approve the rezone of CAD Property ID 85-8540-0470-00 or 182381 Rabb Heights, BLK 47-48-49, being 1.4980 acres. La Feria, Cameron County, Texas located at 11572-11552 Business Hwy 83 from R-1 single family residential district to MF- Multi-Family residential district. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Garcia and passed unanimously.

9. PRESENTATION BY USDA REGARDING POTENTIAL PROJECTS.

Roel Gomez of USDA Edinburg Local Office made a presentation to the Commission regarding different types of funding available to the city for large capital projects such as street and drainage improvements. There was no action taken on this item.

10. <u>DISCUSSION REGARDING POTENTIAL CAPITAL OUTLAY PROJECTS.</u>

Mr. Sandoval explained that the priority for capital outlay projects is improving drainage for residents as well as street improvements in certain high-traffic areas. Funding for these projects will come from a combination of grants and loans from several state and federal programs. There was no action taken on this item.

Commissioner Lozano made a motion to authorize staff to advertise for requests for proposals for employee group health insurance. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Guevara and passed unanimously.
