There were no comments from the public.

5. CITY ANNOUNCEMENTS AND EVENTS:

Mayor Maldonado noted that the Oleander Street Market would be held on October 12, 2019.

Commissioner Guevara made a motion to move to agenda item #11. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Garcia and passed unanimously.

11. <u>PRESENTATION BY HONORABLE OSCAR LONGORIA, STATE REPRESENTATIVE HOUSE DISTRICT 35.</u>

A. APPROVAL OF MINUTES FOR CITY COMMISSION MEETING HELD SEPTEMBER 24, 2019.

9. CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION ON RESOLUTION 2019-23 IN SUPPORT OF AN APPLICATION TO THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND COMMUNITY AFFAIRS FOR 2019 NON-COMPETITIVE TAX CREDITS FOR LAS PALMAS APARTMENTS.

Commissioner Guevara made a motion to approve Resolution 2019-23 in support of an application to the Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs for 2019 non-competitive tax credits for Las Palmas Apartments. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Garcia and passed unanimously.

10. CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION TO APPROVE A FIRE SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH CAMERON COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO.1.
