**Public Hearing on Petition for Creation of Cameron County Drainage District No. 6 pursuant to Texas Water Code Chapter 56**

WHEREAS, on March 30, 2021, the Commissioners' Court acknowledged the presentment and petition for the creations of the Cameron County Drainage District No. 6 pursuant to the Texas Water Code Chapter 56;

WHEREAS, on March 30, 2021, the Commissioners' Court found the petition is signed by at least twenty (25) resident freehold taxpayers on the proposed Cameron County Drainage District No. 6 and the petition states the necessity, public utility, feasibility, proposed boundaries, and proposed name pursuant to Texas Water Code § 56.014;

WHEREAS, on March 30, 2021, the Commissioners' Court found that a deposit was paid to the Clerk upon filing the petition pursuant to Texas Water Code § 56.015; and

WHEREAS, on March 30, 2021, the Commissioners' Court, having found the requirements of the petition being met, must schedule a public hearing on the petition no earlier than 30 days, but no later than 60 days pursuant to Texas Water Code § 56.016.

5. Santa Rosa City Hall, 411 South 6<sup>th</sup> Street, Santa Rosa, Texas 78593.


