3. DETERMINE QUORUM PRESENT AND CALL MEETING TO ORDER - MAYOR

4. PUBLIC COMMENTS

There were no comments from the public.

5. CONSENT AGENDA:

A. APPROVAL OF MINUTES FOR CITY COMMISSION MEETINGS HELD MAY 9, 2023.

Commissioner Garcia made a motion to approve the items under consent agenda as presented. The motion was seconded by Mayor Pro-Tem Guevara and passed unanimously.

6. OATH OF OFFICE ADMINISTERED TO COMMISSIONER-ELECT PLACE 5.

Commissioner- Elect Esmeralda Lozano was sworn in. There was no action taken on this item.

7. CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION ON RESOLUTION 2023-13 ACCEPTING CONSTRUCTION OF THE REHABILITATION OF THE 1.0 MGD CLARIFIER AND ALLIED WORK AT THE CITY OF LA FERIA'S WATER TREATMENT PLANT PROJECT AS COMPLETE.

Commissioner Garcia made a motion to table this item. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Lozano and passed unanimously.

8. CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION ON RESOLUTION 2023-14 APPROVING FINANCING FOR THE PURCHASE OF WATER METERS.

Mr. Rios explained that all of the City's meters would be either updated or replaced within the next year. The purchase includes software to monitor the meters and eliminates the need for manual meter reading. Representatives of Aguaworks informed the commission that some accounts with older meters will likely see an increase in their monthly bills due to the improved accuracy of the new meters. Older meters wear down over time and do not record usage as accurately. City staff will be installing all of the new meters and they will be covered by a 20-year warranty. Commissioner Lozano made a motion to approve Resolution 2023-14 approving financing for the purchase of water meters. The motion was seconded by Commissioner

Martinez and passed unanimously.

9. <u>CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION ON REQUEST TO CLOSE A SECTION OF EAST OLEANDER STREET ON JULY 8, 2023.</u>

Commissioner Lozano made a motion to approve the request to close a section of East Oleander Street on July 8, 2023, from 5:00 pm to 8:00 pm. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Martinez and passed unanimously.

10. <u>CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION ON ORDINANCE 2023-05 ALLOWING ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AT VETERANS MEMORIAL SPORTS PARK ON SATURDAY JULY 1, 2023.</u>

Mayor Pro-Tem Guevara made a motion to approve Ordinance 2023-05 allowing alcoholic beverages at Veteran's memorial Sports Complex on Saturday July 1, 2023, for the Independence Day Celebration. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Zuniga and passed unanimously.

11. <u>CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION ON RESOLUTION 2023-15 APPOINTING MEMBER TO THE INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION BOARD.</u>

Mayor Pro-Tem Guevara made a motion to approve resolution 2023-15 appointing Mary Rodriguez to replace Gloria Casas on the Industrial Development Corporation board. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Garcia and passed unanimously.

There being no further business to discuss, Commissioner Lozano made a motion to adjourn the meeting. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Martinez and passed unanimously.
