PUBLIC COMMENTS

There were no comments from the public.

5. CONSENT AGENDA:

a. <u>APPROVAL OF MINUTES FOR CITY COMMISSION MEETINGS HELD APRIL 25, 2023.</u> Commissioner Garcia made a motion to approve the items under consent agenda as presented. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Martinez and passed unanimously.

Mayor Pro-Tem Guevara made a motion to move to item #8 of the agenda. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Martinez and passed unanimously.

8. <u>CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION ON PRELIMINARY AND FINAL PLAT FOR VILLAS DE SAN LORENZO SUBDIVISION.</u>

Mr. Ortiz explained that the subdivision was approved by the Planning & Zoning Board at their last meeting. He noted that the subdivision will have a retention pond to alleviate drainage. Commissioner Martinez made a motion to approve the preliminary and final plat for villas de San Lorenzo Subdivision. The motion was seconded by Mayor Pro-Tem Guevara and passed unanimously.

6. PUBLIC HEARING ON ZONE CHANGE REQUEST FROM R-1 SINGLE FAMILY RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT TO R-3 SINGLE FAMILY RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT TO ALLOW DUPLEX CONSTRUCTION ON LOTS 36 TO 47 MAIN STREET SUBDIVISION.

Mayor Maldonado opened the public hearing at 6:34 pm. Mr. Ortiz explained that the requested zone change would allow for the construction of twelve duplex structures. A representative of the subdivision developers explained that the units would be more like townhouses. There were no additional comments and the public hearing was closed at 6:38 pm.

7. CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION ON ZONE CHANGE REQUEST FROM R-1 SINGLE FAMILY RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT TO R-3 SINGLE FAMILY RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT TO ALLOW FOR DUPLEX CONSTRUCTION ON LOTS 36 TO 47 MAIN STREET SUBDIVISION.

Mayor Pro-Tem Guevara made a motion to deny the zone change request from R-1 Single Family Residential District to R-3 Single Family residential District to allow for duplex construction on lots 36 to 47 Main Street Subdivision. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Garcia and passed unanimously.

9. <u>CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION ON RESOLUTION 2023- 12 APPOINTING MEMBERS TO THE UTILITY BOARD.</u>

Commissioner Lozano made a motion to appoint Dario Sanchez to the Utility Board. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Martinez and passed unanimously.
