### 4. PUBLIC COMMENTS

There were no comments from the public.

#### 5. CONSENT AGENDA:

## A. <u>APPROVAL OF MINUTES FOR CITY COMMISSION MEETING</u> HELD AUGUST 25, 2020.

Commissioner Guevara made a motion to approve the items under consent agenda as presented. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Lozano and passed unanimously.

### 6. <u>PUBLIC HEARING TO RECEIVE INPUT REGARDING THE PROPOSED</u> TAX RATE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020-2021.

Mayor Maldonado opened the public hearing at 6:31 PM. There were no comments from the public. The public hearing was closed at 6:32 PM.

# 7. CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION TO EXTEND DECLARATION OF LOCAL DISASTER PERTAINING TO THE PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY PERTAINING OUT OF PUBLIC HEALTH ISSUES ARISING OUT OF THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC.

Commissioner Martinez made a motion to extend the declaration of local disaster pertaining to the public health emergency pertaining out of public health issues arising out of the COVID-19 pandemic. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Lozano and passed unanimously.

8. CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION ON REQUEST FROM CAMERON COUNTY ELECTIONS DEPARTMENT FOR USE OF THE LA FERIA PUBLIC LIBRARY FOR EARLY VOTING FROM OCTOBER 13, 2020 TO OCTOBER 30, 2020 AND ELECTION DAY NOVEMBER 3, 2020.

The area in the library being requested is the first-floor computer room. Commissioner Lozano suggested that the best location for the election would be the City's recreation center. After some discussion, the commission found that the library would present obstacles for voters due to the lack of parking space and the small size of the room being requested by the elections department. Staff would also be required to relocate all of the equipment in the computer room to accommodate more voters within social distancing guidelines. Commissioner Lozano made a motion to deny the request from Cameron County Elections Department for use of he La Feria Public Library for early voting from October 13, 2020 to October 30, 2020 and election day November 3, 2020. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Martinez and passed unanimously.

9. CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION TO SUBMIT A BALLOT FOR TEXAS MUNICIPAL LEAGUE BOARD OF TRUSTEES ELECTION.

Commissioner Guevara made a motion to select Robert Herrera, John Fullan, Jeffrey Snyder and Robert Hauck for Texas Municipal League board of Trustees election. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Martinez and passed unanimously.

10. CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION TO APPROVE AN AMENDMENT TO AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN TROPICAL TEXAS BEHAVIORAL HEALTH AND CITY OF LA FERIA ACTING BY AND THROUGH THE LA FERIA POLICE DEPARTMENT.

Commissioner Martinez made a motion to approve an amendment to an interlocal agreement between tropical Texas Behavioral Health and City of La Feria, acting by and through the La feria Police Department. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Guevara and passed unanimously.

11. CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION ON RESOLUTION 2020-13 ESTABLISHING HOLIDAYS TO BE OBSERVED DURING FISCAL YEAR 2020-2021.

Commissioner Lozano made a motion to approve Resolution 2020-13 establishing holidays to be observed during fiscal year 2020-2021. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Garcia and passed unanimously.
