LA FERIA CHRISTMAS PARADE 2023 OFFICIAL RULES AND GUIDELINES

THEME: "A Charlie Brown Christmas"

DAY/DATE: Saturday, December 9, 2023

START TIME: 6:00 P.M. (Line up starts at 3:30 P.M.)

GENERAL RULES

Line Up – The parade will form at Central Avenue and travel north on Main Street, and the final destination will be the La Feria High School Parking Lot. ALL Entries Must be in their assigned numbered space by 5:30 P.M.

The parade route length is approximately one 1 mile long.

NOTHING MAY BE THROWN TO THE AUDIENCE ALONG THE PARADE ROUTE. THIS INCLUDES, BUT IS NOT LIMITED TO CANDY AND COSTUME JEWELRY.

HANDING OUT CANDY OR OBJECTS TO THE CROWD IS PERMITTED BY WALKERS ONLY; HOWEVER, TWO WALKERS MUST ACCOMPANY THE FLOAT/ENTRY, ONE ON EACH SIDE OF THE STREET.

FLOATS

Floats must be decorated and may be pulled by tractor, car, or truck. The vehicle pulling the float will not be judged. If sound/music is included in the theme, and a sound system is not included within the float itself, a vehicle with a sound system will be allowed to follow the float.

- 1) FIRE EXTINGUISHERS ARE REQUIRED TO BE ON EVERY FLOAT FOR EMERGENCY PURPOSES
- 2) ALL FLOATS MUST INCLUDE ADULTS
- 3) NO ONE WILL GET ON OR OFF A FLOAT OR ANY ENTRY ONCE THEY HAVE STARTED THE PARADE ROUTE.
- 4) ENTRY NUMBERS WILL BE PLACED ON ALL ENTRIES BY THE DESIGNATED PARADE OFFICIAL DURING LINE-UP.
- 5) ONCE THE NUMBER IS PLACED IT MAY NOT BE REMOVED UNTIL THE END OF THE ROUTE.

AWARDS

PRIZES WILL BE AWARDED TO THE TOP THREE FLOATS. JUDGING OF ALL THE ENTRIES WILL BE HELD BY A PANEL OF JUDGES, STATIONED ON THE EAST SIDE OF MAIN STREET AND INDUSTRIAL WAY IN FRONT OF DOLLAR TREE.

ENTRIES WILL USE THE THEME: "A Charlie Brown Christmas"

TROPHY & CASH PRIZES

A cash prize and Trophy will be awarded to 1st, 2nd, & 3rd Place FLOATS!

1st place prize - \$ 500.00 2nd place prize - \$ 300.00 3rd place prize - \$ 200.00

Winners will be announced at the Judging station at 7:30 P.M.

GUIDELINES

1. SCHOOL/SCHOOL RELATED CLUBS

In order to improve the safety of all participants including children, Teachers and Sponsors need to inform their students the exact location number for the Parade Line up.

2. MARCHING BANDS

Bands are expected to provide music and showmanship during the parade. All participating bands must participate according to the official lineup.

3. DRILL TEAM/DANCE GROUPS/CHEERLEADERS

All dance and drill teams, cheerleaders, or baton twirlers should march as a team, with a band, or ride on a float. **Those riding on a float will not be permitted to get off to perform along the parade route.** The vehicle pulling the float will not be judged. If sound/music is necessary for a team marching without a band or riding on the float, a vehicle with a sound system will be allowed to precede the group.

4. THEMATIC GROUPS

Thematic groups (clown cyclist, etc.) should perform along the parade route. If sound/music is necessary to convey the theme, a vehicle with a sound system will be allowed to precede the group.

5. CAR CLUB/MOTORCYCLE CLUBS

A maximum of ten (10) vehicles may be included per club. Motorcycle riders will not be allowed to "pop wheelies" or otherwise endanger themselves or other parade attendees and audience. **Cars or Motorcycles may not "peel-out"** during the parade. Rules will be strictly enforced (No exceptions).

GUIDELINES (Cont'd)

6. HORSE GROUPS

Horses will be at the final segment of the parade. A maximum of six (6) horses with riders per group is permitted. All horses must have a VS 10-11or Coggins papers indicating the horse has tested negative for Equine Infectious Anemia as per Texas Animal Health Commission Chapter 49 regulations.

7. **DISTANCE**

Each participant needs to maintain a distance of fifteen (15) feet between each entry. LARGE GAPS MUST BE AVOIDED.

8. POLITICAL SIGNS

No political signs of any kind will be allowed within the parade.

9. <u>DISBANDING</u>

Floats with children under the age of 17 and student marching/units will be directed to disband behind the High School next to the Stadium and will be escorted by Teachers to their designated pick up area inside the La Feria High School West Parking Lot. The floats and any other vehicles will travel behind the La Feria High School and park or they may exit onto Canal Street and travel south to Business 83. Parents may pick up their children from the designated areas.

Please note that no one will be able to drive out of the La Feria High School parking lot until the parade has completely disbanded. Our goal is to ensure safety to all who attend the parade and everyone's cooperation is appreciated.
