A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY OF LA FERIA, TEXAS TO SUPPORT AND PARTICIPATE IN A COUNTY-WIDE FLOOD PROTECTION STUDY FUNDED PARTIALLY BY A GRANT FROM THE TEXAS WATER DEVELOPMENT BOARD AND COMMIT TO CONTRIBUTE \$5,000 TOWARDS THE LOCAL MATCHING FUNDS.

WHEREAS, Cameron County has been awarded a grant from the Texas Water Development Board for a County-wide Flood Protection Study; and

WHEREAS, The Texas Water Development Board grant provides \$450,000 towards the estimated project cost of \$900,000; and

WHEREAS, Cameron County has minimal topographic relief and is highly affected by heavy tropical rain events causing wide spread flooding; and

WHEREAS, Major portions of Cameron County are not provided flood protection through Drainage District improvements; and

WHEREAS, Cameron County requests the participation of local cities and drainage districts to support and contribute a portion of the required local match; and

WHEREAS, Cameron County Commissioner's Court has committed on February 18<sup>th</sup>, 2019 with Resolution No. 2019CO2055, a cash amount of \$150,000 as 33.3 percent of the total match; and

WHEREAS, The City of La Feria agrees to provide a cash amount of \$5,000 as a 1.1 percent of the total match.

## NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF LA FERIA, TEXAS, THAT:

- 1. The City understands that the Cameron County Commissioners Court authorized the grant and accepted the award from the Texas Water Development Board for Flood Protection Planning Study.
- 2. The City understands that the Cameron County Commissioners Court entered into a contract with the Texas Water Development Board and committed the required local matching funds.
- 3. The City agrees with Cameron County to participate and contribute towards the match as required by the Texas Water Development Board.
