

**RESOLUTION NO. 2020-09**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF LA FERIA, TEXAS AUTHORIZING, IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 26.04 (c-1) OF THE TEXAS TAX CODE, THAT A DESIGNATED OFFICER OR EMPLOYEE CALCULATE THE VOTER-APPROVAL TAX RATE FOR TAX YEAR 2020 IN THE MANNER PROVIDED FOR A SPECIAL TAXING UNIT AT EIGHT PERCENT (8%).**

**WHEREAS**, the Governor of the State of Texas has declared a state of disaster in Cameron County pursuant to State Law; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 26.04(c-1) of the Texas Tax Code provides that the governing body of a taxing unit located in an area declared to be a disaster area by the Governor or by the president of the United States may direct a designated officer or employee to calculate the voter-approval tax rate in the manner provided for a special taxing unit at eight percent (8%); and

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the City of La Feria, acting through its governing body, hereby requests, in accordance with Section 26.04 (c-1) of the Texas Tax Code, the Finance Director to calculate the voter-approval tax rate for tax year 2020 in the manner provided for a special taxing unit at eight percent (8%).
