At 6:30 P.M., Board President Mr. Jose Becerra led everyone present in reciting the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America. He then declared that a quorum of the LFIDC Board was present and called the meeting to order.

3. PUBLIC COMMENTS

There were no comments from the public.

4. <u>CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION ON LEASE AGREEMENT FOR THE LFIDC-OWNED PROPERTY LOCATED AT 122 E. COMMERCIAL AVE.</u>

The property is currently being leased for \$900 per month. Mrs. Casas made a motion to extend the lease agreement for one year at the same price. The motion was seconded by Mr. Loya and passed unanimously.

5. CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION ON SALE OF SALE OF 3.73 ACRES OF LFIDC-OWNED PROPERTY LOCATED AT THE INTERSECTION OF RABB RD. AND EXPRESSWAY 83, IN CONJUNCTION WITH A POSSIBLE PERFORMANCE AGREEMENT, WITH TRADECON INDUSTRIES.

Mr. Loya made a motion to go into closed session for legal consultation. The motion was seconded by Mrs. Casas and passed unanimously.

The meeting was called back to open session at 7:30 PM. Mr. Loya made a motion to approve a sale price of \$123,090 for the property financed over a ten-year period with an interest rate of 7%. He also moved to approve \$50,000 in economic incentives if certain benchmarks were met. The motion was seconded by Mrs. Gloria Loya and passed unanimously.

6. CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION ON SALE OF SALE OF 3 ACRES OF LFIDC-OWNED PROPERTY LOCATED AT THE INTERSECTION OF RABB RD. AND EXPRESSWAY 83, IN CONJUNCTION WITH A POSSIBLE PERFORMANCE AGREEMENT WITH ALVARO MEDINA.

Mr. Loya made a motion to sell the property for fair market value. The motion was seconded by Mrs. Gloria Loya and passed unanimously.
