#### 3. PUBLIC COMMENTS

## 4. <u>CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION ON MINUTES FOR THE LFIDC MEETING HELD</u> MARCH 9, 2022.

Mrs. Casas made a motion to approve the minutes for the meeting held on March 9, 2022. The motion was seconded by Mr. Loya and passed unanimously.

## 5. CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION ON SALE OF 6.73 ACRES OF LFIDC-OWNED PROPERTY LOCATED AT INTERSECTION OF RABB RD. AND EXPRESSWAY 83.

Representatives from TradeCon and Southern Industrial Careers Center presented a proposal to purchase the property and develop a retail shopping center. They are requesting to finance the purchase of the property over ten years at 7% interest. They are also requesting a grant from the LFIDC in the amount of one hundred thousand dollars.

Mr. Loya made a motion to convene in closed session for attorney consultation. The motion was seconded by Mrs. Casas and passed unanimously.

The meeting was reconvened in open session at 7:31 PM.

Mr. Loya made a motion to accept the offer from TradeCon to purchase the property for \$215,360 and \$100,000 of grant funding contingent on a performance agreement. The motion was seconded by Mrs. Casas and passed unanimously.

### 6. PRESENTATION AND DISCUSSION REGARDING 2022 APPRAISED VALUES FOR LFIDC-OWNED PROPERTIES.

Mr. Ortiz presented the board will the tax appraisals for all LFIDC property. Most values decreased from the previous year. There was no action taken on this item.

There being no further business to discuss, Mr. Loya made a motion to adjourn the meeting. The motion was seconded by Mrs. Gloria Loya and passed unanimously.
