MINUTES OF PROCEEDINGS SPECIAL MEETING LA FERIA INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION (LFIDC) Thursday, September 3, 2020

Be it known that the Board of Directors of the La Feria Industrial Development Corporation (LFIDC) met in regular session on <u>Thursday</u>, <u>September 3, 2020 at 6:30 PM</u>, via Zoom Teleconference. The purpose of said meeting was to consider and take action on such business as was duly posted by agenda in accordance with State Open Meetings Law.

At 6:30 P.M., Board President Ramon Gonzales led everyone present in reciting the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America. He then declared that a quorum of the LFIDC Board was present and called the meeting to order.

3. PUBLIC/CITIZEN COMMENT

There were no comments from the public.

4. <u>APPROVAL OF FINANCIAL AUDIT FOR FISCAL YEAR ENDING SEPTEMBER 31,</u> 2019.

Mr. Loya made a motion to approve the financial audit for fiscal year ending September 31, 2019. The motion was seconded by Mr. Becerra and passed unanimously.

5. WORKSHOP TO DISCUSS BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020-2021.

Mr. Rios presented an overview of the budget including an expected revenue from lease properties in the amount of \$173,763. He also noted that sales tax revenue will remain on par with previous years and has not been seriously affected by the Covid-19 pandemic. budgeted expenses include nearly 65 thousand dollars in property taxes and a bank note in the amount of 39 thousand dollars. The note is set to mature in 2023. There was no action taken on this item.

6. <u>CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION TO APPROVE BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020-2021.</u>

Mr. Loya made a motion to approve the budget for fiscal year 2020-2021. The motion was seconded by Mr. Gonzalez and passed unanimously.

Mr. Gonzales called the meeting in to Closed Session at 6:50 P.M.
