5. CONSENT AGENDA:

a. <u>APPROVAL OF MINUTES FOR REGULAR CITY COMMISSION MEETING HELD DECEMBER 5, 2023.</u>

Mayor Pro-Tem Guevara made a motion to approve the items under consent agenda as presented. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Lozano and passed unanimously.

6. <u>CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION ON ORDINANCE 2024-01 CLOSING CERTAIN STREETS FOR FIESTA DE LA FERIA ON FEBRUARY 17, 2024.</u>

Commissioner Lozano made a motion to approve Ordinance 2024-01 closing certain streets for Fiesta de La Feria on February 17, 2024. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Zuniga and passed unanimously.

7. PRESENTATION BY PERDUE BRANDON FIELDER COLLINS & MOTT LLP OF THE DELINQUENT COLLECTION REPORT JULY 1, 2022 – JUNE 30, 2023.

Representatives of Perdue, Brandon, Fielder Collins &Mott, LLP presented statistical information on their collection of delinquent taxes and court fines. There was no action taken on this item.
