At 6:30 P.M., Board President Mr. Jose Becerra led everyone present in reciting the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America. He then declared that a quorum of the LFIDC Board was present and called the meeting to order.

3. Consideration and possible action on a Resolution to authorize the sale of LFIDC-owned real property located at 421 West First Street in La Feria to Synergy Advantage, LLC.

4. Consideration and appropriate action to approve the LFIDC Audit for FY 2021-2022.

The motion was seconded by Mr. Munoz and passed unanimously.
