The purpose of said meeting was to consider and take action on those items of City Business as was duly posted by agenda in accordance with State Open Meetings Law. <u>3. DETERMINE QUORUM PRESENT AND CALL MEETING TO ORDER – MAYOR</u>

There were no comments during this item.

5. <u>CONSENT AGENDA:</u>

a. <u>APPROVAL OF MINUTES FOR CITY COMMISSION MEETING HELD JULY 23, 2024.</u>

b. <u>CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION TO APPROVE THE FINANCIAL AUDIT</u> <u>FOR FISCAL YEAR ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2023.</u>

Commissioner Lozano made a motion to approve the items under consent agenda with corrections to item 8 of the minutes for the meeting held July 23, 2024. During that item the commission requested that the City Manager provide renderings of the proposed "Lions Park" and confirm with the funding agency that the grant could be used on other existing parks. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Martinez and passed unanimously.

Commissioner Lozano made a motion to move to item #13. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Martinez and passed unanimously.

13. <u>DISCUSS AND APPROVE AWARD TO SELECTED GRANT MANAGEMENT FIRM FOR</u> <u>GRANT PRE-APPLICATION, APPLICATION, AND IMPLEMENTATION SERVICES FOR</u>

THE CITY OF LA FERIA 2025-2026 TEXAS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT GRANT FUND PROGRAM AS ADMINISTERED BY THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE.

Mr. Rios explained that Grantworks was the only firm to respond to the RFP. Nelda Briones of Grantworks addressed the Commission and stated that the grant amount was up to \$750 Thousand and funds could be used for parks, streets and water projects. The city would be responsible for matching 10% of the awarded funding. Commissioner Lozano made a motion to select Grantworks for grant Management firm for grant pre-application, application and implementation services for the City of La Feria 2025-2026 Texas Community Development Grant Fund Program as administered by the Texas Department of Agriculture. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Garcia and passed unanimously.

6. <u>CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION REGARDING A PROPOSED TAX RATE</u> <u>CALCULATION FOR TAX YEAR 2024 (FISCAL YEAR 2024-2025), AND SET DATES FOR</u> <u>PUBLIC HEARINGS ON THE CITY FY 2024-25 BUDGET AND PROPOSED TAX RATE.</u>

Commissioner Lozano made a motion to approve the proposed tax rate and set public hearings for September 17, 2024. The motion passed unanimously with all Commissioners voting aye.

Commissioner Lozano requested several revisions and clarifications be added to the Ordinance including definitions for waiver, SUP, variance and application. Commissioner Lozano made a motion to postpone this item to a later date. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Martinez and passed unanimously.

8. <u>CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION TO SELECT A PROVIDER FOR BANK</u> <u>DEPOSITORY SERVICES.</u>

Mr. Castillo addressed the commission and made the recommendation to continue using Texas National Bank for bank depository services. Commissioner Lozano made a motion to select Texas National Bank for bank depository services. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Martinez and passed unanimously.
