

RESOLUTION 2026-13

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF LA FERIA, TEXAS, CITY COMMISSION AUTHORIZING APPLICATION FOR FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE IN THE FORM OF WATER SUPPLY AND INFRASTRUCTURE GRANTS FROM THE TEXAS WATER DEVELOPMENT BOARD; AND MAKING CERTAIN FINDINGS IN CONNECTION THEREWITH

WHEREAS, the City of La Feria, Texas (“City”) has experienced significant challenges with regulation of water supply and wishes to improve underlying water supply infrastructure to meet the needs of its residents;

WHEREAS, the Texas Water Development Board (“Board”) has invited the City to submit application for funding; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Board, which govern the procedures in making such an application, the governing body of the City is required to pass resolution to accompany such application; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LA FERIA, TEXAS THAT:

1. An application is hereby approved and authorized to be filed with the Texas Water Development Board seeking financial assistance in an amount not to exceed \$10,000,000.00 (ten million dollars) to provide for the costs of water system and infrastructure improvements funded through the Texas Water Development Board-Water Supply and Infrastructure Grant Program.
2. The City cannot reasonably finance the Project without the financial assistance of the Board in the amount requested.
3. That the City Manager and City Secretary of the City are each hereby designated as authorized representatives of the City for the purpose of furnishing such information and executing such documents as may be required in connection with the preparing and filing of such application for financial assistance and with complying with the rules of the Board.
4. That the following firms and individuals are hereby authorized and directed to aid and assist in the preparation and submission of such application and appear on behalf of and represent the City before any hearing held by the TWDB on such application, to-wit:

5. A certified copy of this resolution shall be attached to the application for financial assistance herein authorized to be prepared and submitted to the Board, and the City Secretary of the City is authorized and directed to prepare and certify such number of copies of this resolution as may be required for purposes of supporting the submission of such application to the Board.
6. The recitals contained in the preamble hereof are hereby found to be true, and such recitals are hereby made a part of this resolution for all purposes and are adopted as a part of the judgment and findings of the City.

7. All ordinances and resolutions, or parts thereof, which are in conflict or inconsistent with any provision of this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, and the provisions of this Resolution shall be and remain controlling as to the matters resolved herein.
8. This Resolution shall be construed and enforced in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas and the United States of America.
9. If any provision of this Resolution or the application thereof to any person or circumstance shall be held to be invalid, the remainder of this Resolution and the application of such provision to other persons and circumstances shall nevertheless be valid, and the City hereby declares that this Resolution would have been enacted without such invalid provision.
10. It is officially found, determined, and declared that the meeting at which this Resolution is adopted was open to the public and public notice of the time, place, and subject matter of the public business to be considered at such meeting, including this Resolution, was given, all as required by Chapter 551, as amended, Texas Government Code.
11. This Resolution shall be in force and effect from and after its passage on the date shown below.
